## Find Your Zipper Size

Before you order the FixnZip<sup>®</sup>, you should determine your zipper sizes.

Start by checking the back of your broken zipper slider; most zippers have a size number (1-10) embossed on the back of the slider. Once you know your zipper size, our sizing chart below will determine which FixnZip® is right for you.

Small: Sizes 1 - 4



Examples: trousers, light fleeces, bags, fine garments & many other fine zips.

Medium: Sizes 5 - 7



Examples: side zip boots, bags, tactical vests, tents, sleeping bags, jackets & more


Large: Sizes 8 - 10



Examples: heavy duty clothing & bags, canvas tents, jeep windows & wet suits

## Measure Your Zipper

If your zipper doesn't have a number on the back, you can simply measure the width of the zipper teeth in millimeters or inches.



## Teeth/Coil Width

1 to 4.5 mm | 0.04 to 0.18 in = Small 5 to 7.5 mm | 0.19 - 0.30 in = Medium 8 to 10 mm | 0.31 - 0.40 in = Large
